Webinar on “AWARENESS PROGRAM FOR PLASTIC USAGE”

An Awareness program on usage of Single use plastic was held by NSS Unit, GNIT at 2:00 PM on 26/02/2021. The objective of conducting this program was to aware the students and faculty about the potential threats caused by usage of plastic and its littering leading to its improper collection and dumping.

Use of plastic has overshadowed the use of natural materials used in manufacturing such as paper, glass and cotton. Plastic usage has a potential threat to not just the environment but it also affects human health and animal health in numerous ways. Plastic is mostly made from oil and natural gas. These are both non-renewable, so most plastic is non-renewable. A tiny bit of plastic is being made from vegetable organic material, so that bit is biodegradable, and renewable. Another such threat to our ecosystem is from the improper handling and treating dumped plastic wastes. Plastics can take anywhere between 20 to 500 years to decompose completely depending on its material and structure. This makes plastic a potential threat to our environment and attempts should be made to create awareness on how to not use single use plastic products specifically.

Today's program is one such event to create awareness of the environmental hazard caused by the use of plastic amongst the students and faculty of GNIT, Nagpur. Prof. Geetanjali Kale addressed the program and shared the motive of conducting it at an institute level. Also, she heartily welcomed Hon'ble Principal, for his relentless support and cooperation in every endeavor at GNIT.

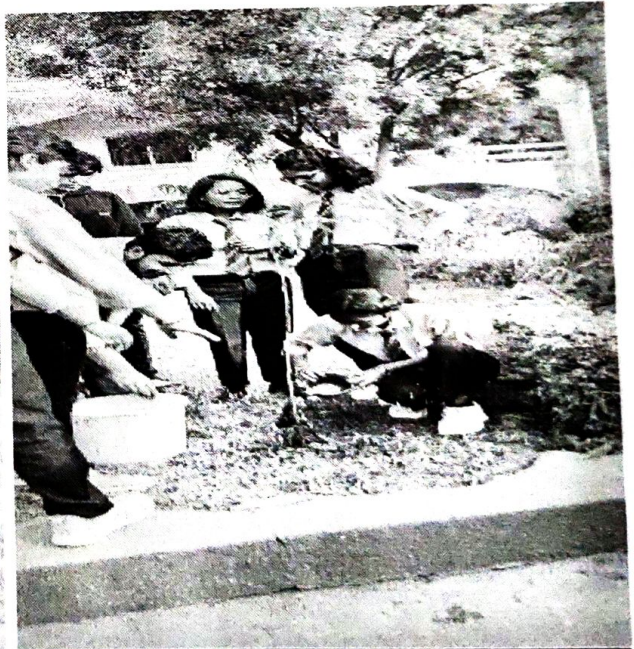
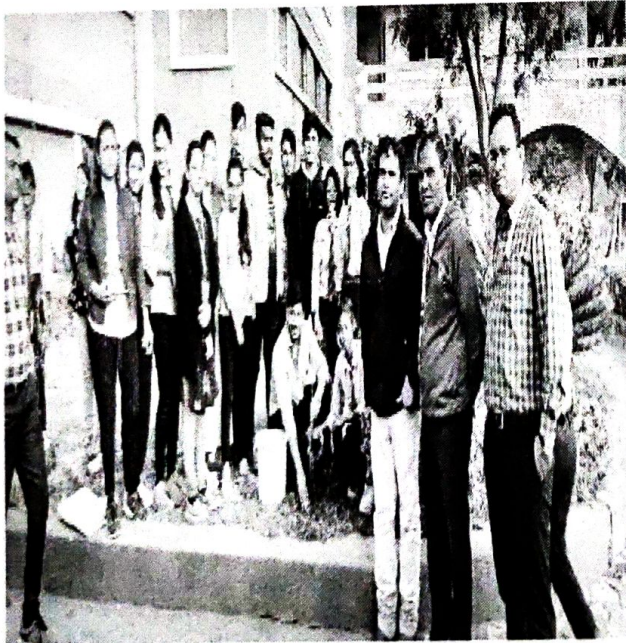

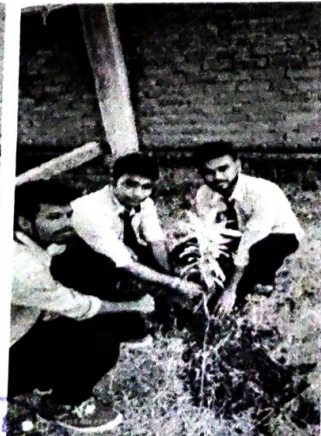
