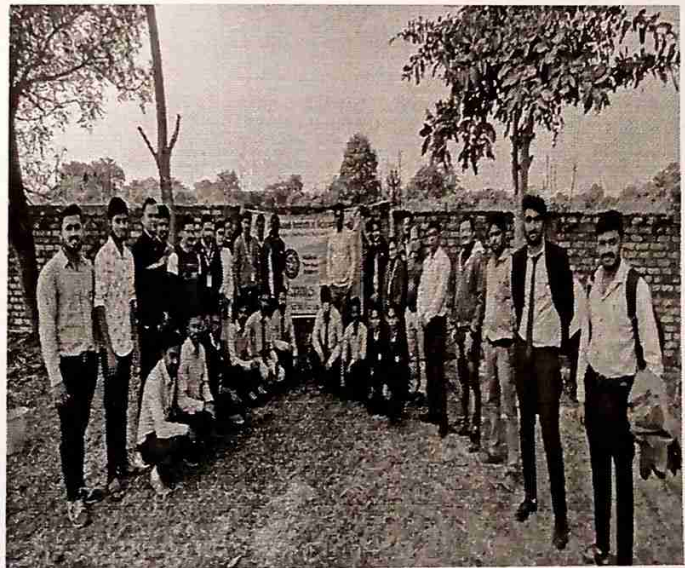



REPORT ON TREE PLANTATION

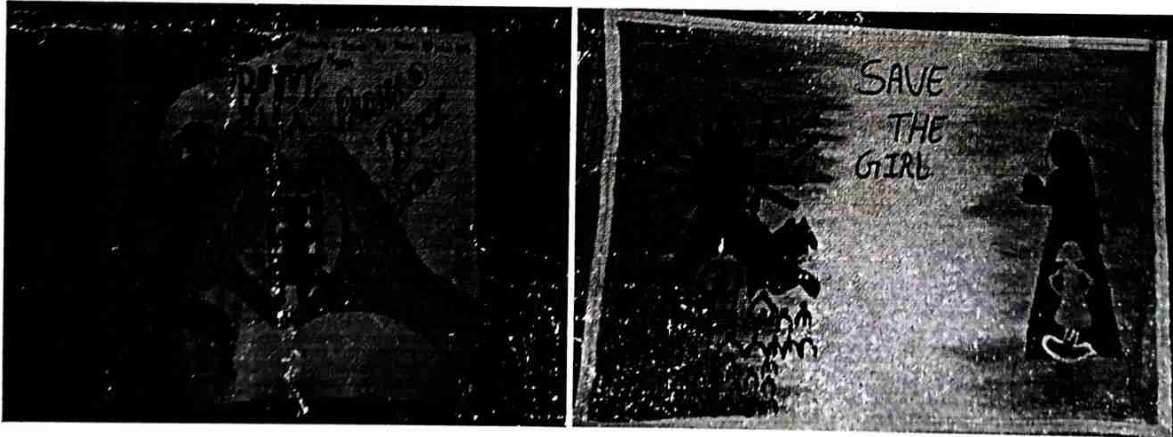
Report of Online Poster Competition on "Beti Bachao Beti Padhao"

UNNAT BHARAT ABHIYAN (UBA)

UBA is a reflection of- Gandhi ji's idea to develop the Indian society was based on his understanding of the society and hence based on the village system. Talking about the importance of village, he wrote in 1936, "I would say if the village perishes, India will perish too."

Preamble:

As foreseen by Gandhi Ji in his seminal work, 'Hind Swaraj', the western developmental paradigm, based on centralized technologies and urbanization, has given rise to serious problems like increasing inequity (leading to crime and violence), and climate change due to rapid ecological degradation. To ameliorate these problems, it is necessary to promote development of rural areas in tune with Gandhian vision of self-sufficient 'village republics', based on local resources and using decentralized, ecofriendly technologies so that the basic needs of food, clothing, shelter, sanitation, health care, energy, livelihood, transportation, and education are locally met. This should be the vision of holistic development of villages. Presently, 70% of the population in India lives in rural areas engaged in agrarian economy with agriculture and allied sector employing 51% of the total work-force but accounting for only 17% of the country's GDP. There are huge developmental disconnects between the rural and urban sectors such as inequity in health, education, incomes and basic amenities as well as employment opportunities - all causing great discontent and large-scale migration to urban areas. The imperatives of sustainable development which are being felt more and more acutely all over the world also demand eco-friendly development of the villages and creation of appropriate employment opportunities locally. Increasing urbanization is neither sustainable nor desirable. So far, our professional higher education institutions have largely been oriented to cater to the mainstream industrial sector and, barring a few exceptions, have hardly contributed directly to the development of the rural sector. 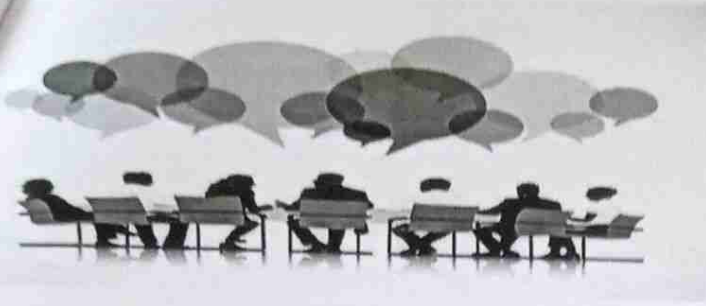

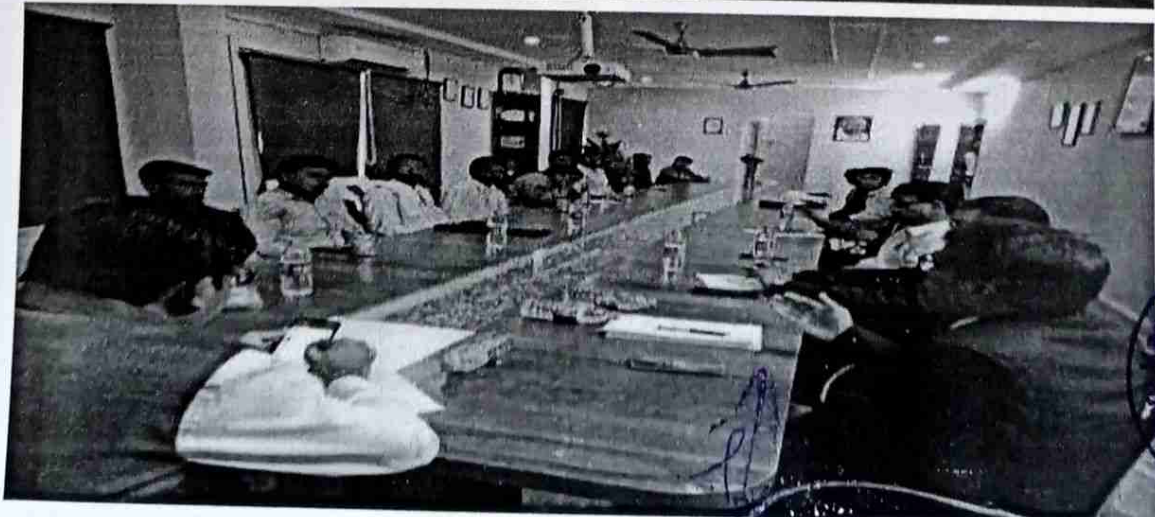


1. Initiation With Sarpanch

The sarpanchas of the villages approved the project conceptualized by GNIT, Nagpur and agreed to co-operate & help the entire staff during the various activities of the project till its completion. They are also eager to see that their village is an Eco-sustainable village.

Outcome: Sarpanch's keen interest impacted a lot on the villages as the corporation and willingness to participant got a huge recognition.





3. Gram Sabhas in Adopted Villages to Identify Community needs.

The Gram Sabha meeting with the Gram Panchayat members, Village citizens, Members of non-government organizations is conveyed at all five Adopted villages of Kalmeshwar Taluka on 13-04-2022 at 09.00am to discuss on implementation of MHRD sponsored UBA activities of the Government of India and Also Discussed critical issues being faced by the villagers with sarpanches and village representatives. Prof. Chetna P. Shelke., Coordinator of UBA of GNIT, Nagpur explained the purpose and motto of UBA program. Also briefed about the implementation of UBA scheme in the Village. The Grama Sabha members are asked to give suggestions about solutions to the problems of the village. And also asked to discuss one of the major issue to be resolved under UBA grant. The members of the village suggested to install the Solar Street lights in certain areas of the village, few suggested to provide computers to government School students in the village, few Suggested to install Water filter etc. Along with this discussion also collected the primary data as a part of snap shot Audit. Now conceptualization and crystallization of the collected data for further course of action is being done.

Outcome: Sarpanch got to know that which scheme are needed in village and present status of villages towards making self sustainable



5. Household Survey in adopted villages

UBA team of GNIT has completed Reconnaissance and snap shot Audit alongwith Household survey with a remarkable effort of Prof. Chetna Shelke Coordinator,UBA Cell, GNIT and Dr.N.S.Raman Dean, R&D. under the enthusiastic guidance of our Dr.Sudhir N.Shelke, Principal. GNIT-Director, GNES

Reconnaissance and snap shot Audit -and House hold survey has been completed in all the 5 identified and adopted Villages with a view to make them sustainable and self-driven , Presently , we are in Second phase activity i.e. house hold survey.

In this activity, student coordinator, students of various departments and faculties were involved. In this survey we discussed the critical issues with villagers and surpanches also we filled out the Questionnaire. We collected data from villagers about their critical issues being faced by them. Now we are in the process of critical analysis of issues and we are working towards easy solutions which villagers can use and they can solve their issues independently without technical inputs.

HISTORY AND SIGNIFICANCE

The Coronation of Shivaji Maharaj took place on June 6, 1674. On this auspicious day, he began early in the morning, adorning white robes and praying to his deities. Gaga Bhatta, the priest from Varanasi, was present to perform Shivaji Maharaj's Coronation. The two main rituals to take place in the coronation were the 'Abhishek'* on the king and the holding of the 'chatr'* over the king. On the golden platform, Shivaji Maharaj sat with his wife, Soyrabai, and his son, Sambhaji. His eight ministers were ready with a pot full of sacred water from rivers like Ganga. With religious spells from the priest, Abhishek Shivaji Maharaj was carried out of the sacred waters by eight ministers. After this, Shivaji Maharaj, wearing red robes and ornaments, and a crown, worshipped his sword, armour, bow, and arrow. He then entered the coronation place and sat on the throne. People acclaimed "Shivraj ki Jai" as "Shivraj ki Jai." The skies were filled with acclamations. Shivaji Maharaj's throne and said, "Chhatrapati." Salutations were given from various forts, blowing the cannons.

The event proved to be a milestone in Maratha history as it also marked the beginning of Hindavi Swarajya in India. It was on this day when Shivaji was given the title of 'Shakakarta' which means 'founder of an era' in English and 'Chhatrapati' (paramount sovereign)..
