- Duration of the programs and extended stay in each country.

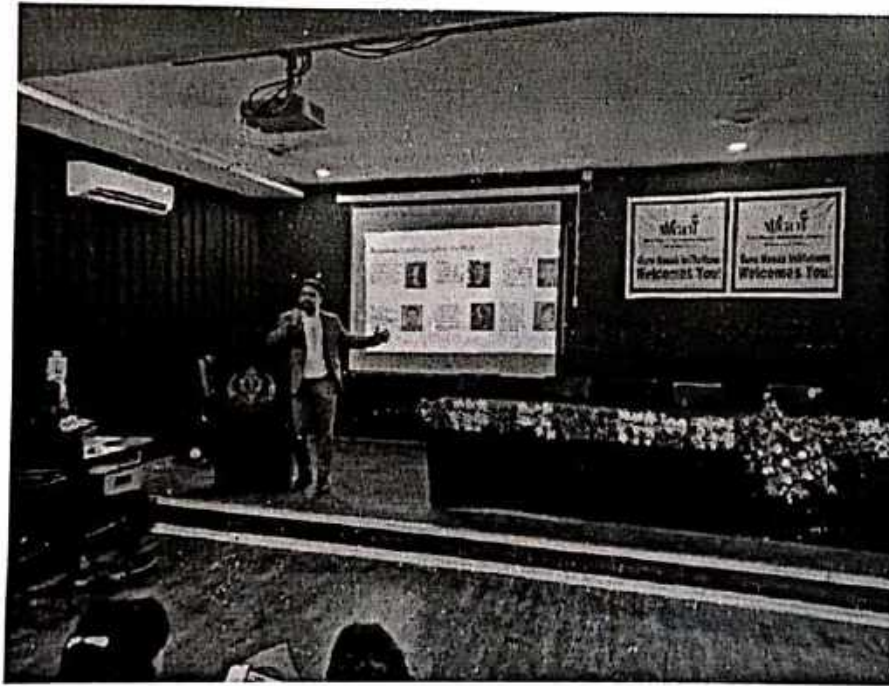

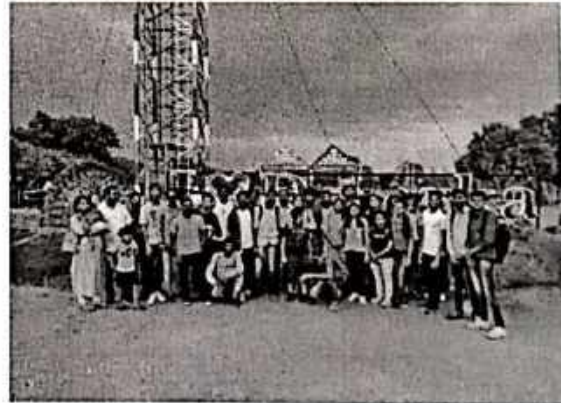


Report on Celebration of "Teachers Day"

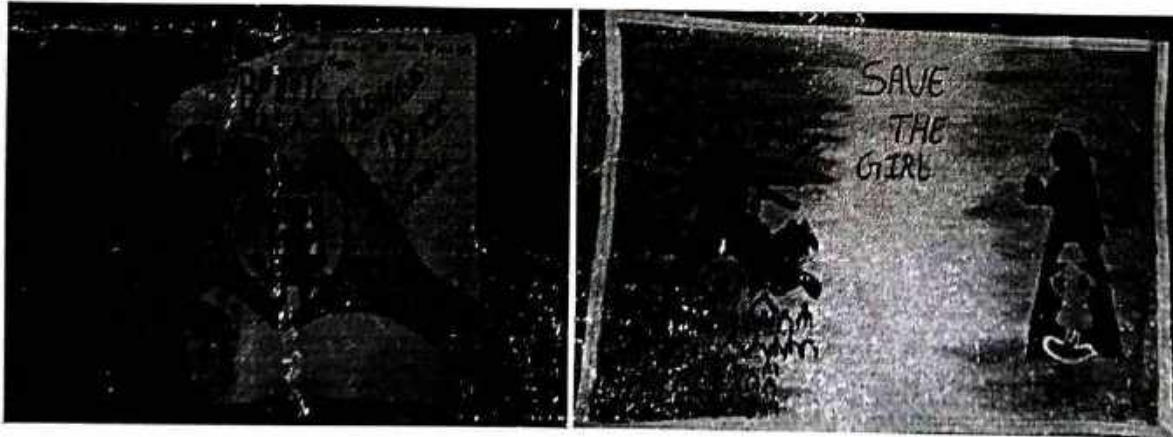
Report of Online Poster Competition on "Beti Bachao Beti Padhao"

HISTORY AND SIGNIFICANCE

The two main rituals to take place in the coronation were the 'Abhishek'* on the king and the holding of the 'chatr'* over the king. On the golden platform, Shivaji Maharaj sat with his wife, Soyrabai, and his son, Sambhaji. His eight ministers were ready with a pot full of sacred water from rivers like Ganga. With religious spells from the priest, Abhishek Shivaji Maharaj was carried out of the sacred waters by eight ministers. After this, Shivaji Maharaj, wearing red robes and ornaments, and a crown, worshipped his sword, armour, bow, and arrow. He then entered the coronation place and sat on the throne. People acclaimed "Shivraj ki Jai" as "Shivraj ki Jai." The skies were filled with acclamations. Shivaji Maharaj's throne and said, "Chhatrapati." Salutations were given from various forts, blowing the cannons.

The event proved to be a milestone in Maratha history as it also marked the beginning of Hindavi Swarajya in India. It was on this day when Shivaji was given the title of 'Shakakarta' which means 'founder of an era' in English and 'Chhatrapati' (paramount sovereign)..
